WIL Board Member Milena Harito, VP IT & Network: Europe from Orange shared her wisdom and unique experience with our Talents in a special 1 hour session moderated by WTP8 Talent Magdel Wessels, Consumer Team Leader at Lenovo. In the first half of the event, Milena covered the lessons she had learnt from a varied career spanning both the public and private sectors before participants had the chance to put their questions to her.

Having been at the forefront of digital transformation throughout her time at Orange, and as a former government minister in Albania, there were no shortage of questions put to Milena on what makes a great leader.
